WORKSHOP MINUTES
January 11, 2022**

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 6:06 BY MAYOR SCHENKER

OPENING STATEMENT: Adequate notice of this meeting has been given in accordance with the directives of the "Open Public Meetings Act", pursuant to Public Law 1975, Chapter 231. Councilman Porretta questioned Resolution #2022-28 and asked to table the resolution until next month.

Councilman Conway gave Council a handout regarding a new proposed tree ordinance. A discussion ensued.

Councilman Blazer reported that the Borough has received the Recreational Grant for \$40,000.00.
