February 11, 2020**

**MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 6:07 PM BY MAYOR GREG SCHENKER**

**OPENING STATEMENT:** Adequate notice of this meeting has been given in accordance with the directives of the “Open Public Meetings Act”, pursuant to Public Law 1975, Chapter 231. Said notice of this meeting has been advertised in the Hammonton Gazette and has been posted on the Borough Hall bulletin board showing the time and place of said meeting.

**Al Norman (28 Park Avenue)** stated that he felt that cutting trees should be done by professionals with years of experience and not by our Public Works Dept. with limited training.

Mayor Schenker discussed appointing Councilman Jake Blazer, Councilman Greg Conway and Planning Board member Glen Smith to the Landsale Committee. A land sale discussion ensued. There will be a motion during the regular Council meeting. Councilman Conway stated that you could list the properties for sale in the Newsletter that will be out sometime in March or April.

Mayor Schenker discussed the Veteran’s Advisory Board and the application for individuals to submit to be on the board. A discussion ensued.
