WORKSHOP MINUTES  
March 12, 2019**

**MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 6:14 PM**

**OPENING STATEMENT:** Adequate notice of this meeting has been given in accordance with the directives of the "Open Public Meetings Act", pursuant to Public Law 1975, Chapter 231. Mayor DeStefano reported to Council that South Jersey Industries informed him that they will be moving their Folsom employees to another facility while they do renovations to their building which should take approximately one year.

Mayor DeStefano asked the John LaPollo to contact the FAA and see if they could use the storage trailer that the School has offered to the Borough.

Attorney John Carr stated he would have the necessary ordinances for next month's meeting regarding the Master Plan changes.

Mayor DeStefano inquired about the status of the CCO inspections. There was a discussion to have the Zoning Officer takeover the safety inspections at the Borough. The Ordinance must be changed first to allow the Zoning Officer to do them.

Mayor DeStefano asked about the email John LaPollo sent to Council regarding a tree on Park Avenue that a resident requested the Borough remove. John went out and inspected the tree and it could not be determined if the tree was on Borough property. Town Engineer Vince Polistina stated he would go to the property and inspect the tree.

Councilman Conway inquired about the collapsed garage on Mays Landing Road. Councilman Conway will ask our Zoning Officer to send a letter.

Councilman Hoffman informed Council that our Zoning Officer is in contact with the Pinelands and DEP regarding the illegal dam on 14<sup>th</sup> St.

Councilman Schenker stated that he reached out to the State regarding Borough owed land the State maybe interested in purchasing for their Green Acres Program.
