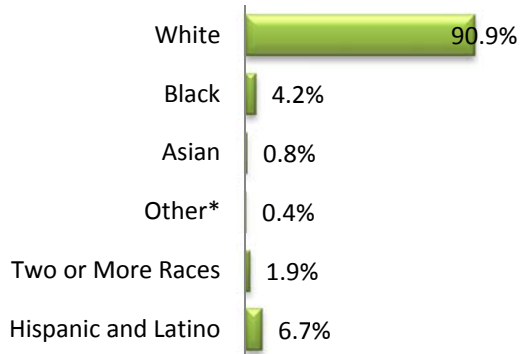

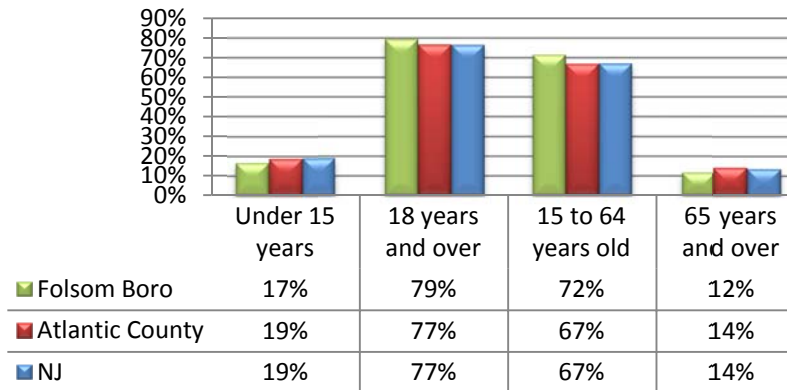

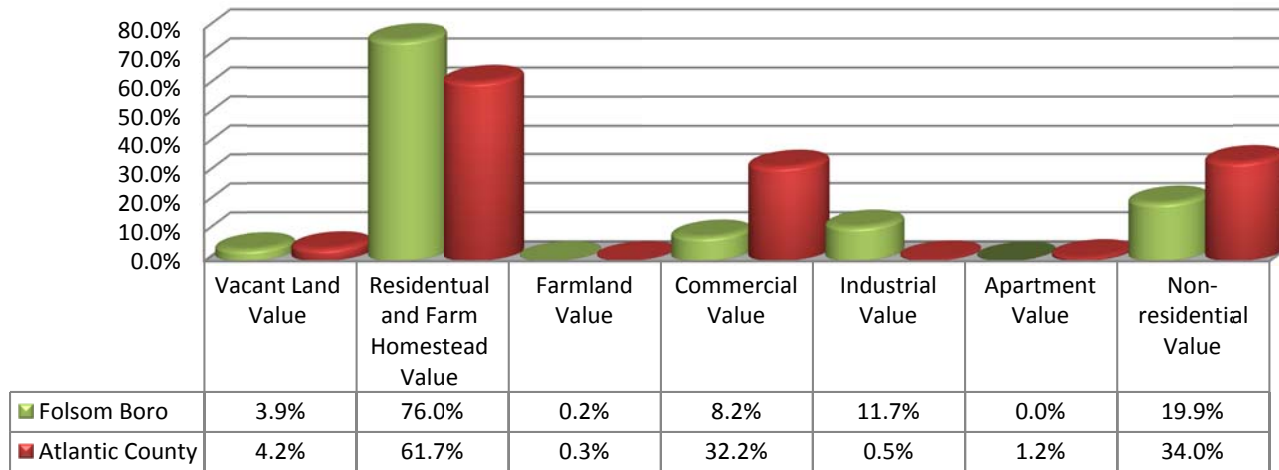

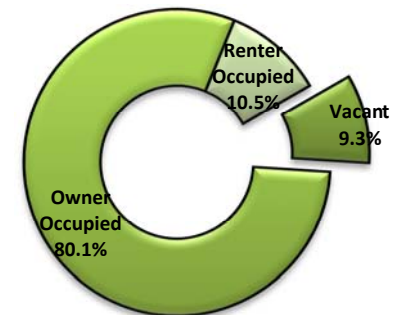

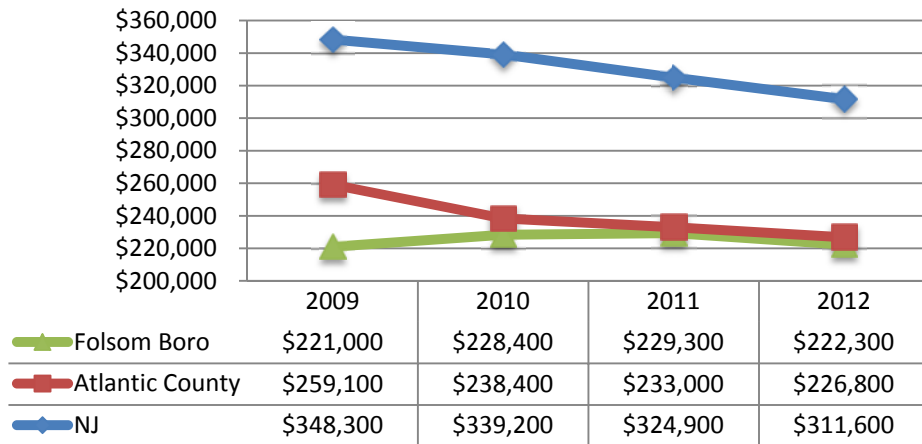

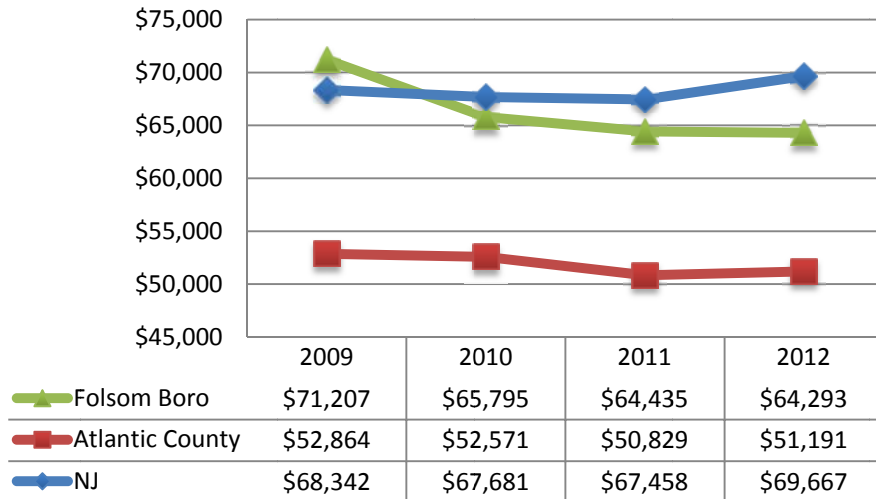

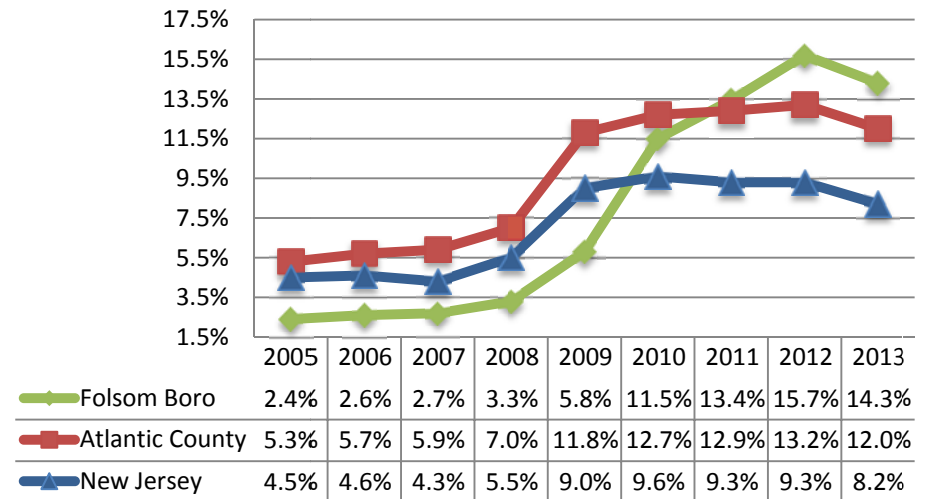

Unemployment Rate

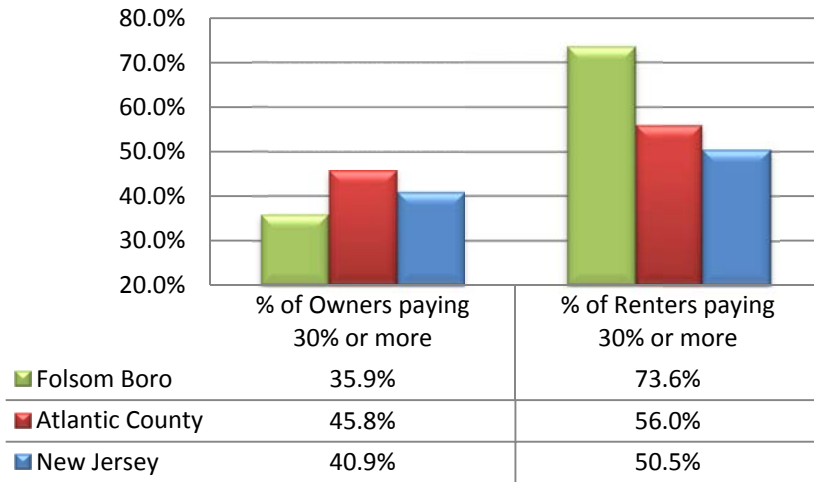

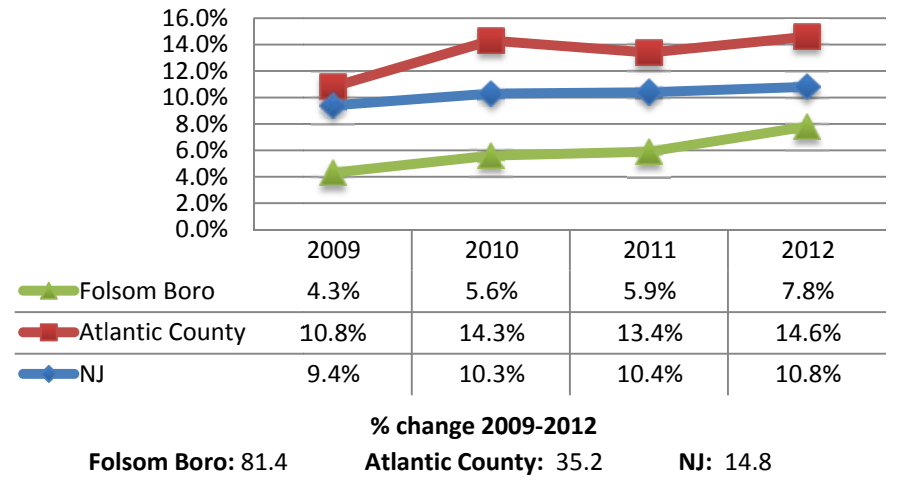

% of Home Owners and Renters Paying more than 30% of their Income on Housing

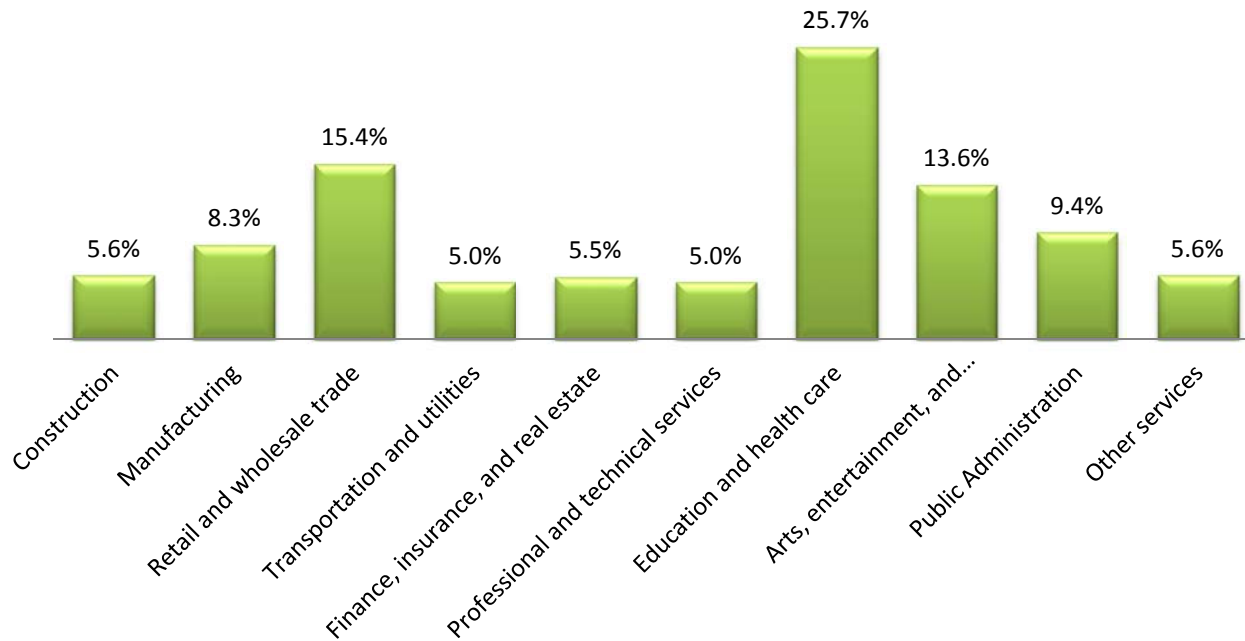


Poverty Rate

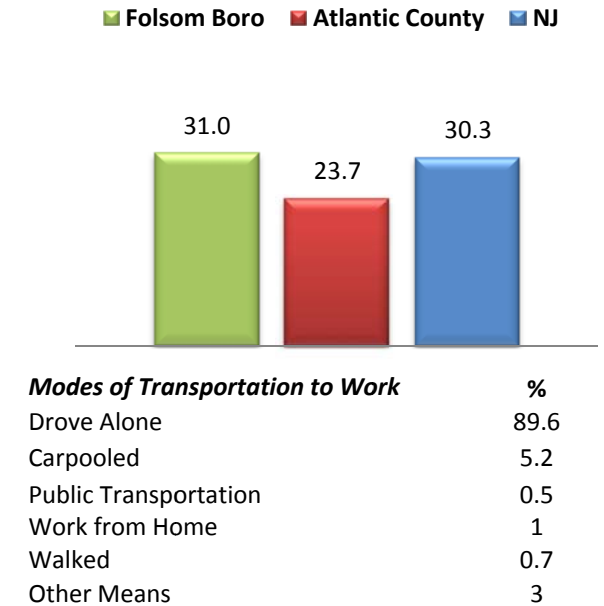

Mean Travel Time to Work (Mins.)

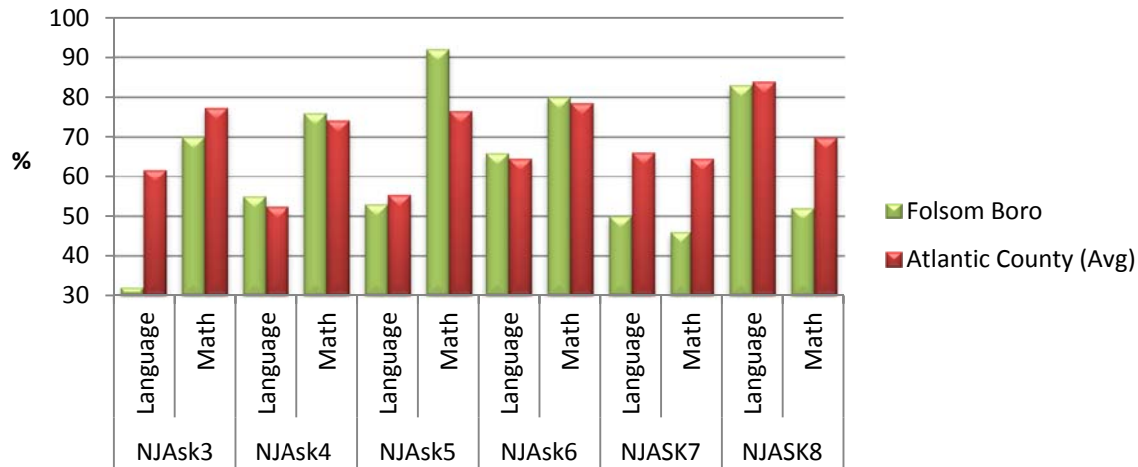

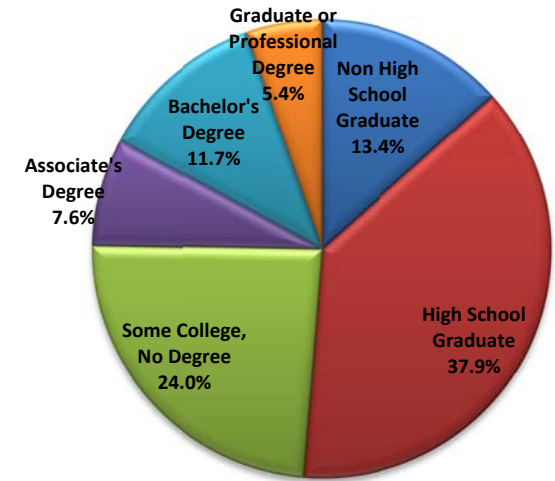

NJASK 3rd-8th Grade: Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient or Higher



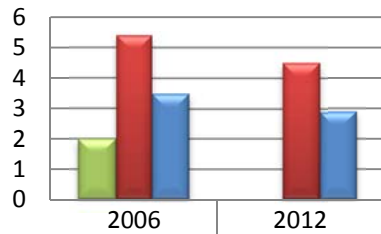
Highest Level of Education Attainment: People 25 years and over

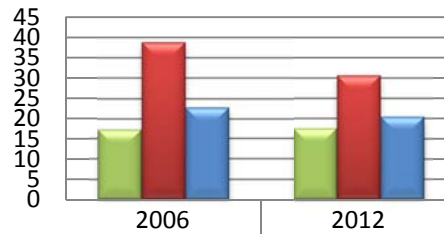

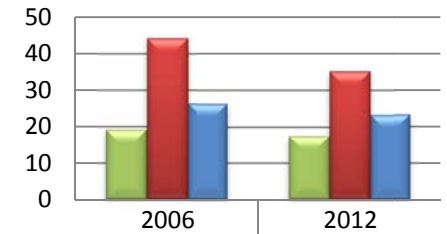
