## **ORDINANCE 06-2012**

# AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF FOLSOM VACATING PORTIONS OF ROAD B AND ROAD C

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Folsom has received a request for the vacation of portions of Road B and Road C; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough has determined that it has no need for these portions of right of way; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.S.A. 40:67-1 allows for the vacation of these portions of right of way of Road B and Road C.

- **NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Folsom, Atlantic County, New Jersey that the Borough hereby vacates its interests in the portions of right of way of Road B and Road C described more fully in the descriptions attached hereto as Exhibit A and Exhibit B prepared by Thomas A. Prendergast, PLS, dated May 10, 2012, and such right of way interest in the property is hereby returned to the adjacent properties being identified as lot 1 of block 2805 on the tax map of the Borough of Folsom.
- **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the vacation of the portions of Road B and Road C is subject to an express reservation and exception from vacation all rights and privileges, if any, possessed by public utilities as defined in <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:2-13 and by any cable television company as defined in <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 40A:5A-1 et seq. to maintain, repair and replace their existing facilities in, adjacent to, over or under the road or any part thereof, being vacated.
- **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the public interest in the vacated portions of Road B and Road C are released in favor of the owner of adjacent lot 1 of block 2805.
- **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** if any provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to such provision and the remainder of this Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
- **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed on the first reading at a regular meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Folsom, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey held on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2012 and said Ordinance will be further considered for final passage, and adoption at a public hearing to be held in the Borough of Folsom Municipal Building, 1700 12th Street, Folsom, New Jersey on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2012 at 7pm or as soon thereafter as the matter may be reached.
