MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 6:47 PM

SALUTE TO THE FLAG LED BY COUNCIL PRESIDENT MATT OLIVE

Council President Matt Olive turned the meeting over to Auditors Bob Swartz and Carol Kiniry from Ford-Scott Associates to discuss the outcome of the 2011 audit. Ms. Kiniry thanked the Borough employees and officials for their assistance and professionalism. It was a successful audit. Mr. Swartz cautioned the Governing Body that the County may be calling for a re-evaluation in the near future.

Council President Olive reviewed Agenda

Public Works Superintendent John LaPollo updated the Governing Body on the Jersey Construction 15th Street and Mays Landing Road situation. Mr. LaPollo indicated that Jersey Construction is willing to repave a portion of the damaged road and is considering planting some White Pines to eliminate some noise from the property. Mr. LaPollo is meeting with Jersey Construction next week to work out the details. John also reported a sinkhole at 2105 14th Street that is being addressed. Mr. LaPollo is still reviewing the electronics program.

Councilman Schenker reminded residents to call the Borough Hall if any street lights are out. Mr. Schenker also stated that he is getting quotes on repairing the roof.
