The Clerk's Office

Vote by mail ballot- registered voters can apply for vote-by-mail by following instructions found at VOTENJ.GOV or contacting your COUNTY Clerk.

In-Person Early Voting- This option enables all registered voters to cast their ballot in person, using a voting machine, prior to Election Day. Visit VOTENJ.GOV to find the nearest designated in-person early voting location. Or, vote in person at Borough Hall from 6:00am to 8:00pm on Election Day. Please call Borough Hall with any questions, or if you need to find out if you're registered to vote!! Election Day is November 8, 2022

Our office issues numerous licenses and permits such as Marriage Licenses, and pet licenses. We also provide notary service. If you see a stray pet, call animal control.

Department of Public Works

Leaf Collection begins October 24th. The last day will be December 19th. Collection will then begin again the 1st Monday in April and end the 3rd Monday in May. Each year, Folsom Borough submits applications for road improvements. This year, Park Avenue and Lakeview Drive have been resurfaced. We are projecting in 2023 to resurface Fenimore Drive, part of Lenape Terrace, Seneca Lane, Cherokee, and part of Mohawk Drive. Questions? Please contact Al Norman.
