**A RESOLUTION TO HIRE A PART-TIME ZONING & CODE ENFORCEMENT
OFFICIAL**

WHEREAS, John Lapollo, who previously held the position of Zoning/Code Enforcement Officer has been released as of Monday, July 28, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Folsom Borough requires a replacement to fill the vacant position in order to maintain operational and continuity and effectiveness;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the Borough of Folsom that Frank Sacco is authorized to be hired as a part-time Zoning Official & part-time Code Enforcement Official, commencing as of July 28, 2025 and ending December 31, 2025, subject to understanding and/or completion of the following:

1. Term: Fill unexpired term until 12/31/25
2. Compliance with the Policies and Procedures of the Borough
3. Office hours available to the Public shall be on Monday, 5:00PM to 7:00PM
4. Additional hours as required for attendance at Municipal Court and

inspections.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that compensation for Frank Sacco shall be based on an annual salary of \$6,525.00. Said wage shall be separately set forth in the Municipal Salary Ordinance as required by NJSA 40A:9-140.10.

A motion was made by Councilman Norman to approve Resolution #2025-85 seconded by Councilman Whittaker

Frank Sacco came before Mayor and Council to introduce himself and answer questions.
